



A Wedding At Wildewood ...your family church

Meaningful weddings...like good marriages...don't just happen. They are the result of careful planning and a good deal of plain hard work. We at Wildewood want your wedding to be both meaningful and memorable...a helpful launching pad for your life together as husband and wife.

Our hope is for you to enter into your marriage centered around Christ. Our desire is that your wedding will be a time of genuine worship. We pray your experience will be an everlasting one as you come before God and your dearest family and friends to take vows that link you together in life "for better or worse"...forever.

May God Bless you during this time of preparation for your new life together.

- Contact the Church Office for an appointment with our pastor well in advance of the wedding day. This will help assure that there are no calendar conflicts and that the Worship Center and Fellowship Hall is available.
- Premarital guidance is required. It is designed to consist of several appointments.
- Decorating the Church and Fellowship Hall should be accomplished in a respectful way that will leave no damage to furniture, pews, walls or any church surroundings.
- Only drip less candles may be used for the protection of the carpets. A protective plastic covering must be used under any candelabras.
- In the event punch is spilled and stains the carpet, the wedding party is responsible for having the carpet professionally cleaned.
- No rice or birdseed may be thrown inside or outside the building.
- Photographers are urged to use discretion in taking pictures of the ceremony. No flashes are allowed after the processional and/or before the recessional in order to not destroy the atmosphere of worship.
- Rehearsal and set-up times must be prearranged before the wedding with the church office.
- Clean-up of personal items must be done after the wedding. We are not able to store candelabras, bows, etc.

A wedding is confirmed on the church calendar when the Church Office receives a deposit of \$150, which is returned after the wedding if no damage to the property occurs or no extra work is created for the maintenance crew, or other church staff.

- Use of Facility Church Members: \$75
Reception at church \$75
- Use of Facility Non-Church Members: \$300
Reception at church: \$100
- Deposit: \$150
Member or Non-member, secures the date
- Pastor-Church Members: An honorarium for the pastor is your gift to the pastor.
- Pastor-Non-Church Members: \$100 for the rehearsal; \$250 for the wedding.
- Sound System Tech: \$50
For church and non-church members

Music for the ceremony should be chosen in conference with the pastor. Various uses of music may be made, such as congregational hymns, vocal or instrumental soloists, or sacred organ music alone.

Wildewood's pianist and organist are available according to their schedule. They have separate fees. Outside accomplished musicians may use the piano and organ with prior approval.

Our desire is that the music at your wedding will enhance the worship experience itself and centered on the shared relationship in Jesus Christ.

All wedding services are provided by a Wildewood pastor. Ministers outside of Wildewood may provide the wedding service with Wildewood Pastor's prior approval.
